Terms and Conditions
of the competition for the Best Conference Paper by a Young Author at the 13th International
Workshop on Robot Motion and Control

A. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

1. The competition is open to individuals who are the first author of an article submitted for presentation at RoMoCo and are :
 - 30 years of age or younger on 1 January 2025.
 - the principal author of the paper.
 - the presenting author of the paper.
2. Application for participation in the competition must be made by e-mail to the PC-IEEE-RAS Secretary (igor.zubrycki@p.lodz.pl) by 15.06.2024 (inclusive).
3. The application for participation in the competition should include:
 - the final version of the article as a 'pdf' file,
 - declaration of willingness to participate in the competition and acceptance of the competition rules, together with additional data (name, affiliation, e-mail address, date of birth) - the mail should include the phrase I am willing to participate in the Best Conference Paper by a Young Author competition and agree to its terms and conditions. The title of the email should be "Application for the Best Conference Paper by a Young Author Competition"

B. SELECTION BOARD AND EVALUATION RULES

1. The competition committee is chaired by a member of the PC-IEEE-RAS. The Commission shall be appointed by the members of the PC-IEEE-RAS Board present at the 13th RoMoCo. A member of the Commission may not be:
 - a person who is a participant in the competition,
 - a co-author of an article submitted to the competition,
 - the academic supervisor or promoter of the person who is a participant in the competition.
2. There are three main elements to be assessed in the competition:
 - the relevance of the results presented to the development of automation and robotics,

- the scope of the results presented in the paper (theory, numerical simulation, experiment),
 - the quality of the presentation of the paper by the contestant during the 13th RoMoCo.
3. The members of the Commission assign points (0-3) for each evaluable element listed in B.2.
 4. On the basis of the total number of points collected, the Commission jointly determines the winner of the competition.
 5. The Competition Committee reserves the right not to award a prize if only papers of insufficient quality are submitted to the competition or if only one paper is submitted.
 6. The decision of the Competition Committee is final and cannot be appealed.

C. ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS AND PRIZE

1. The result of the competition will be announced during the 13th Robot and Motion Conference (RoMoCo), which will take place on 2-4.07.2024 at Poznan University of Technology in Poznań.
2. There will be a cash prize of 700 PLN for the winner of the competition.
3. The prize will be transferred after the 13th RoMoCo as a transfer to the winner's designated bank account.
4. The winner agrees that information about the outcome of the competition will be posted on the PC-IEEE-RAS website.
